

Since April, the Syringa Primary Care Clinic offers services in two separate locations to reduce exposure of contagious disease.

Patients experiencing acute illness such as gastric issues (nausea and or diarrhea), respiratory issues, sore throat or similar symptoms will be seen in the Carmelita Spencer building; 711 W. North street location, Suite 2 located across the street from the clinic and adjacent to Syringa Physical Therapy. (See picture below)

Our patients who are in need of routine healthcare such as obstetrics, well child exams, immunizations, diabetes and other wellness or chronic illness visits will continue to be seen at the Primary Care Clinic at 722 W North Street. (Pictured below)

For your convenience, Syringa offers pharmacy pick-up curb side service. Call 208-494-3050 upon arrival and we'll bring your medications to your vehicle.

Tele-health – The Centers of Medicare & Medicaid issued temporary waivers that enable Tele-health options during the response to the COVID-19 crisis. Syringa is currently offering these services. The visit can be scheduled by calling the clinic registration staff at 208-983-8590. In some cases the provider may request the patient be physically seen.

Your health, the health of our community, and the health of our staff is our top priority. Please let us know your needs and our dedicated staff will assist you with the best options available.

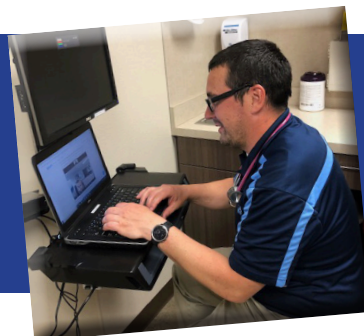
